The game ought to have been level in the 68th minute. Matthews ran clean through in on goal, however scuffed his finish, dragging it narrowly past the post

The visitors also remained a threat in the second half and came very close to doubling their lead in the 70th minute. Wilson picked up the ball on the left-hand side, and whipped a ferocious strike that came crashing off the inside of the far post.

Despite their best efforts, the hosts were not able to find an equaliser. Fleetlands remained resilient and held out to the full time whistle, putting an end to Rec's unbeaten run.
